# GROUNDWATER TRANSFER PROGRAM (the “GTP”)

- **Provided administrative oversight of the GTP systems.**
- **Severn Trent Environmental Services, Inc. (“STES”)** continued to successfully operate the GTP systems.
- **Only one Buyer and one Seller remain in the West GTP System.**
- **Provided an average of 0.4 MGD of water to the Buyer district.**



## **SURFACE WATER CONVERSION**

- **STES continued to successfully bring districts on line and operate the surface water delivery system.**
- **Delivered water to 4 additional districts increasing the number of districts receiving surface water to 27.**
- **During the reporting period delivered an average of 10.59 MGD of surface water.**
- **Through the reporting period have delivered approximately 757 million gallons of surface water.**
- **Baring unforeseen problems, anticipate delivering surface water to an additional approximately 10 to 20 districts during July.**



# MAJOR ACTIVITIES

- **Continued oversight of engineering efforts.**
- **Provided construction administration services and project representative services, as required.**
- **Provided oversight of STES activities and its contract to operate the Authority's systems.**
- **Responded to inquiries from districts concerning the conversion to surface water and the conversion to chloramine disinfection.**
- **Continued to assist the Authority in coordination of the delivery of surface water to the districts in the 2010 service area.**

# MAJOR ACTIVITIES

- Assisted the Authority in developing information for renewal and expansion of the Authority's aggregate water well permit.
- Updated status of districts' efforts concerning the conversion to chloramine disinfection.
