

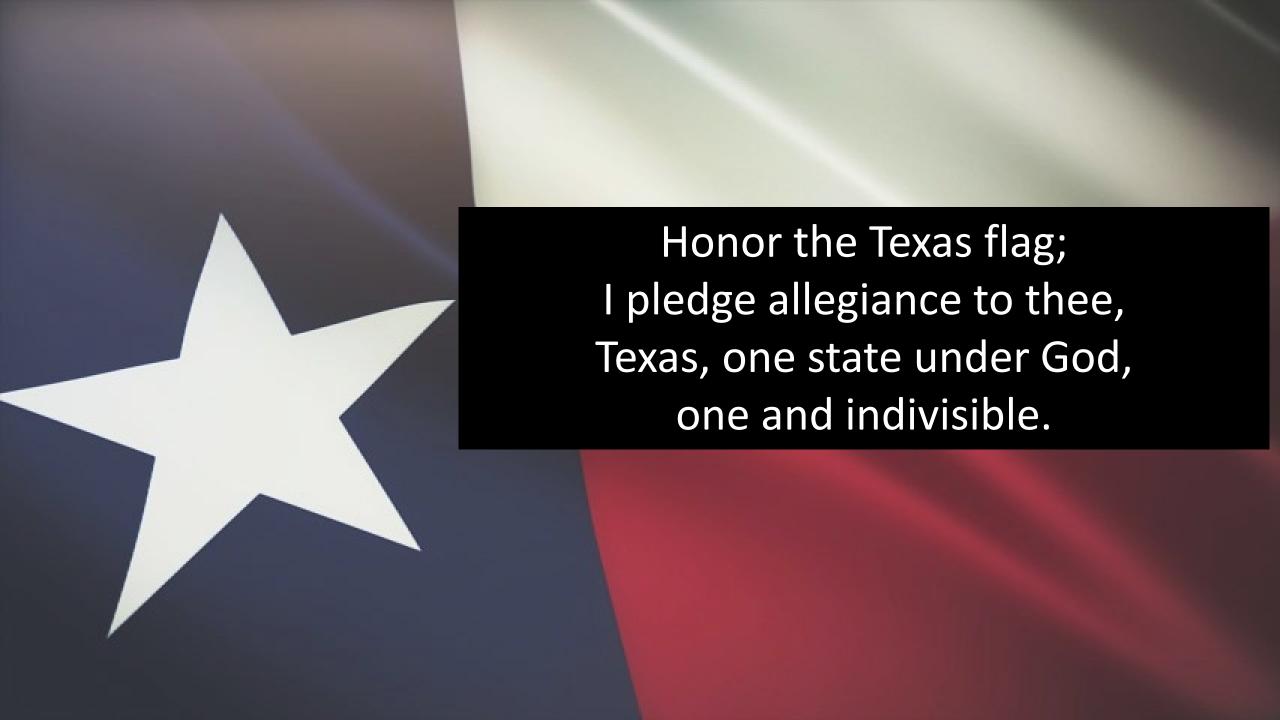

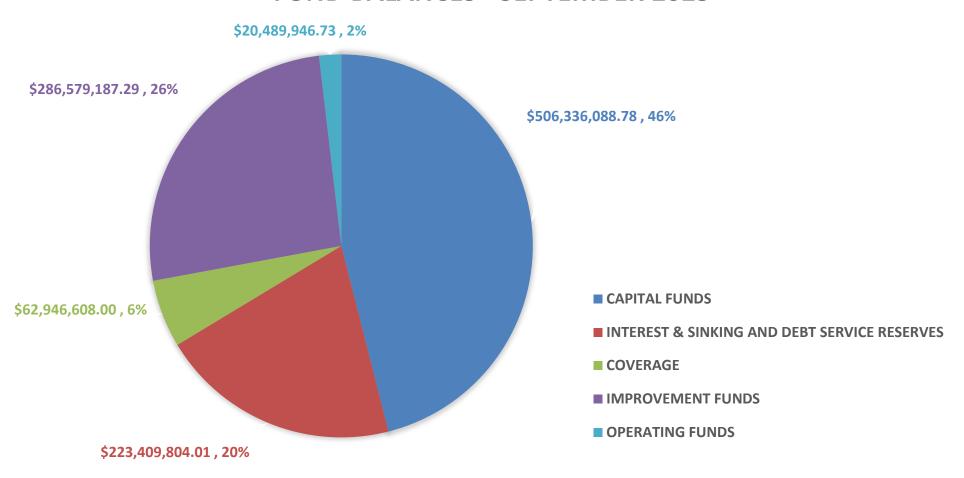

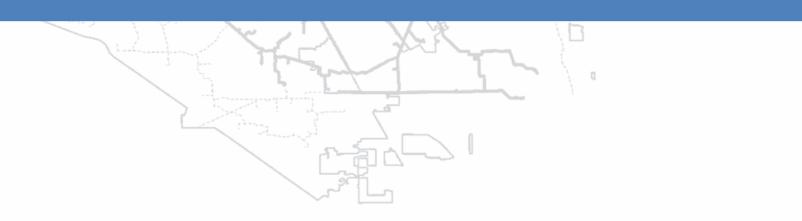

WHEREUPON, the meeting was called to order and evidence was presented that public notice of the meeting had been given in compliance with the law.

#### CALL TO ORDER

Director Rowell, Board President, called the meeting to order, then led the attendees in the Pledges of Allegiance to the United States and Texas flags.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Jerry Homan addressed the Board.

#### WATER MASTER PLAN

Mr. Chang explained the purpose of the Water Master Plan.

Ms. Batson provided the Board with an explanation of the Master Planning process. She then explained the Authority's basis of planning as derived from its enabling legislation and compliance with the HGSD requirements.

Ms. Fritsche next discussed how the Authority's customers use water and the ways in which such water usage has changed over time. She then discussed Spatial Planning Units, demographic projections, single-family and multifamily housing trends, household population and income, job growth, drivers and sensitivity, and projected demands and conversion.

Ms. Batson then presented options and recommendations for filling the water supply gap, and discussed infrastructure needs, conversion requirements, and the timeline and cost to complete such conversions.

#### BOARD GOVERNANCE PLANNING

Director Rowell moved to enter Executive Session to discuss General Manager succession planning, communications, and recruitment. Director Fessler then moved to postpone the discussion.

Mr. Johnson recommended that the Board schedule a special meeting to have a discussion regarding the HGSD presentation as it was not on the agenda. Director Rowell withdrew her motion to enter Executive Session, and Director Fessler withdrew his motion to postpone. Director Ramsey and Director Fessler then requested to hold a special meeting for Monday, October 27, 2025.

#### STATUS OF CURRENT LITIGATION AND RELATED LEGAL MATTERS

This item was not discussed.

#### NEXT MEETING DATE

Director Rowell advised that the next regular meeting will take place on November 3, 2025.

#### ADJOURNMENT

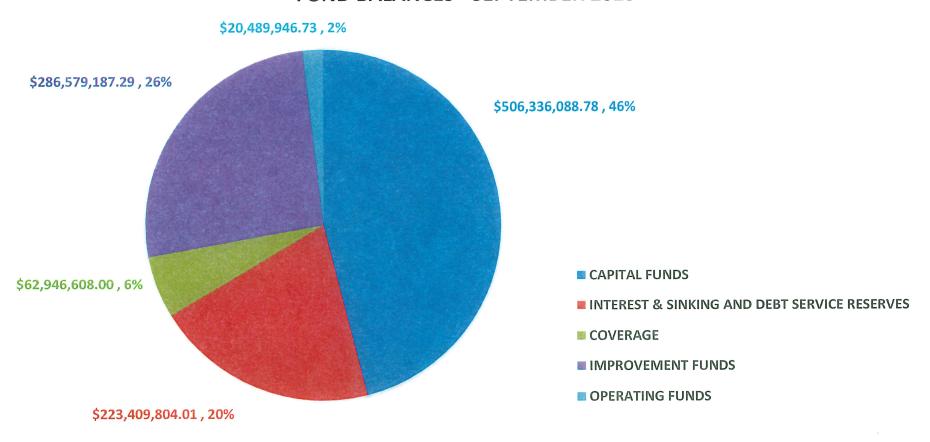


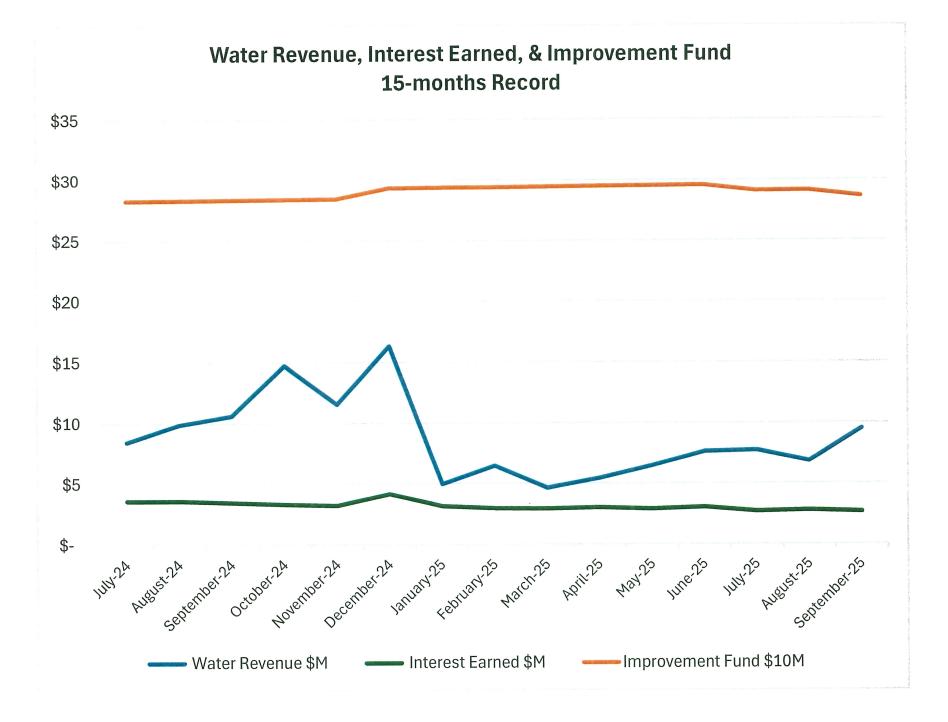

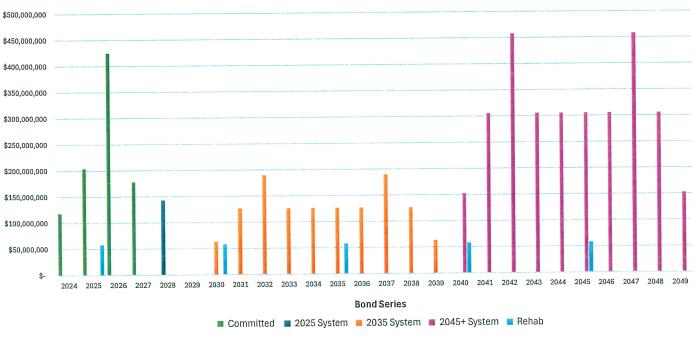
#### **FUND BALANCES - SEPTEMBER 2025**

## **Economic and Market Commentary**

## Slow and steady

October 1, 2025

Another September rate cut and another reason to consider liquidity products.

Common sense would say that when the Federal Reserve (the Fed) lowers its benchmark fed funds target range, as it did by a quarter percentage point two weeks ago, that interest rates and yields across the board would fall in concert. But finance doesn't always operate the way it seems it should (who isn't confused when first told that a bond's price falls when its yield rises).

It is true that yields of securities in the direct market, such as government auctions, overnight trading and floating-rate securities, adjust quickly to changes in the fed funds level, now in a target range of 4.00-4.25%. But that's not the case for many financial products, such as mortgages and liquidity products. Mortgage rates key off the 10-year Treasury; money market portfolios use a "laddered strategy." In a falling-rate environment, this simply means money market portfolios hold securities of different maturities bought with the higher rates available before the Fed cut. This in turn typically causes yields of these portfolios to decline slower than those found in the direct market. That can make them attractive to investors. Other factors also impact the performance of local government investment pools, such as TexPool/TexPool Prime. Among them are the seasonality of participant deposits and withdraws for tax receipts and payroll expenses, for instance. But, as with money market vehicles, the portfolio manager seeks to keep the yield as attractive as possible.

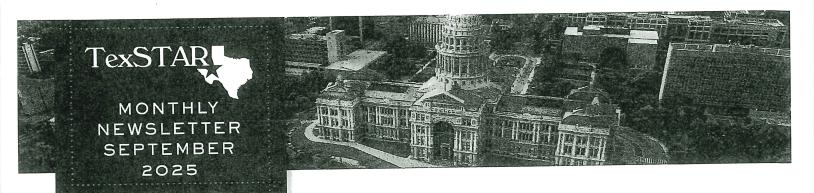

### ECONOMIC COMMENTARY

#### Market review

The third quarter was marked by many twists and turns, with some sources of uncertainty resolved while new ones emerged. The passage of The One Big Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA) provided a clear outline of fiscal policy; and preliminary trade deals reduced some tariff uncertainty, although the ultimate impacts of tariffs remain unknown. Despite these developments, mounting risks to the labor market prompted the Federal Reserve (Fed) to resume its rate-cutting cycle after a nine-month pause. Since the previous Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) meeting in July, two consecutive employment reports have come in softer than expected, painting a picture of a "low fire, low hire" economy with increased downside risks. The August Jobs Report revealed a sharp slowdown in hiring momentum, as nonfarm payrolls increased by just 22,000—well below the consensus of 75,000. Downward revisions to the prior two months further dampened the outlook, removing 21,000 jobs from those periods. In fact, employment now contracted by 13,000 in June, marking the first decline in payrolls since December 2020. The closely monitored unemployment rate rose to 4.3%. Meanwhile, wages rose 0.3% month-over-month (m/m) and 3.7% year-over-year (y/y).

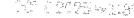
The following week, the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) released preliminary benchmark revisions indicating that 911,000 fewer jobs were added between April 2023 and March 2024, suggesting labor markets were weaker than originally thought. This trend persisted into September, as the ADP employment report indicated a reduction of 32,000 private-sector jobs, compared to a downwardly revised decline of 3,000 in August. On the inflation front, while the statutory tariff rate settled in the high teens, its full impact on inflation data remains ambiguous. (continued page 4)
